Mrs. Dunlap, who has suffered a mental institution after authorities said she admitted starting the fatal fire because "it was God's will that they die."

But Donald doesn't know today his father also died from burns received in the fire.

"We haven't had the heart to tell him about his father yet," the boy's grandmother said. "The child wouldn't know how to go about telling him."
